#### D. Social Distancing

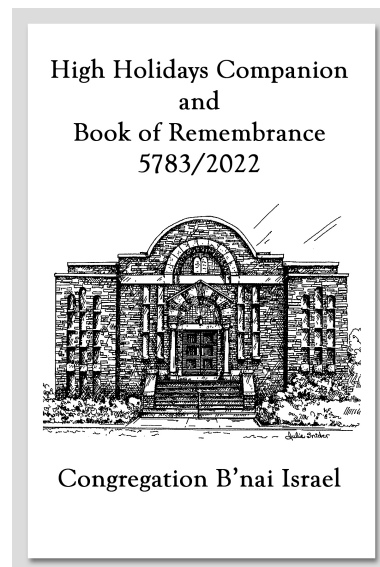
- Strongly encouraged, but not mandatory

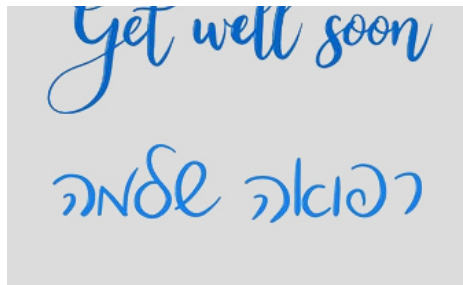

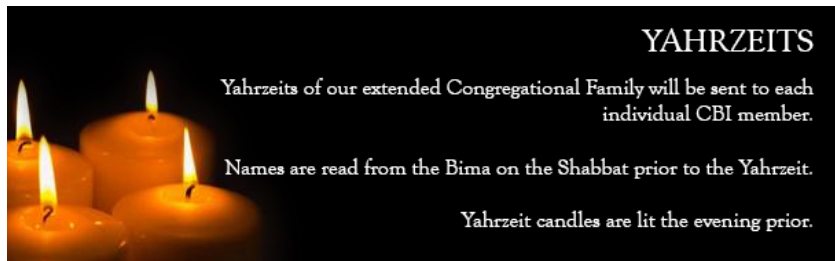

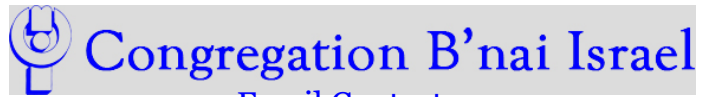
