Current Protocols at CBI

C: For security purposes, all members and guests must pre-register for each of the services they will attend.



A reminder to everyone that Sunday, October 9th, from 10:00 am, we will be erecting and decorating our newly acquired Sukkah in preparation for the next Chag which begins on Sunday evening.

On Shabbat Chol HaMoed Sukkot, which is October 15th this year, we'll celebrate the chag after services with an open-air light lunch in the sukkah. If the weather is uncooperative everyone is invited to come to the Sukkah for Kiddush and Motzi and take some food from the buffet tables set up inside the Sukkah and then go back inside to sit and eat. Remember to take a piece of Challah and eat a small bit of your food selection so you fulfill the mitzvah of eating in the sukkah.

Our office will be sending out a link in due course for Shmini Atzeret services and Yizkor on Monday, October 17th with Rabbi Moshe officiating <u>via Zoom</u>.

Simchat Torah celebrations will be in the sanctuary the same day, Monday, October 17th from 7:00 pm. Come and enjoy the Hakafot with the Torahs and witness the reading of Zot HaBeracha and the end of one cycle and the beginning of Bereshit and the start of the next cycle.

We will be taking down the Sukkah on Thursday, October 20th after regular morning services. All hands on deck will make the job that much easier.
